




Dermott Juvenile Treatment Center is a secure residential treatment facility operated in partnership with the Arkansas Division of Youth Services. The center serves male youth ages 17 to 20, including Extended Jurisdiction Juvenile (EJJ) youth who have aged out of other programs.

Youth at Dermott receive comprehensive therapeutic and educational services, including opportunities to earn vocational certifications. They also participate in evidence-based group programming such as Positive Skill Development (PSD), Positive Organizational Culture (POC), and character skill development groups.

- 17 years old was the average age in 2024
- 91% of discharges were successful exits
- 65 High School diplomas and
 76 GEDs awarded
- 100% compliance with student IEPs
- 1.4 grade equivalent growth in reading
- 2.1 grade equivalent growth in math
